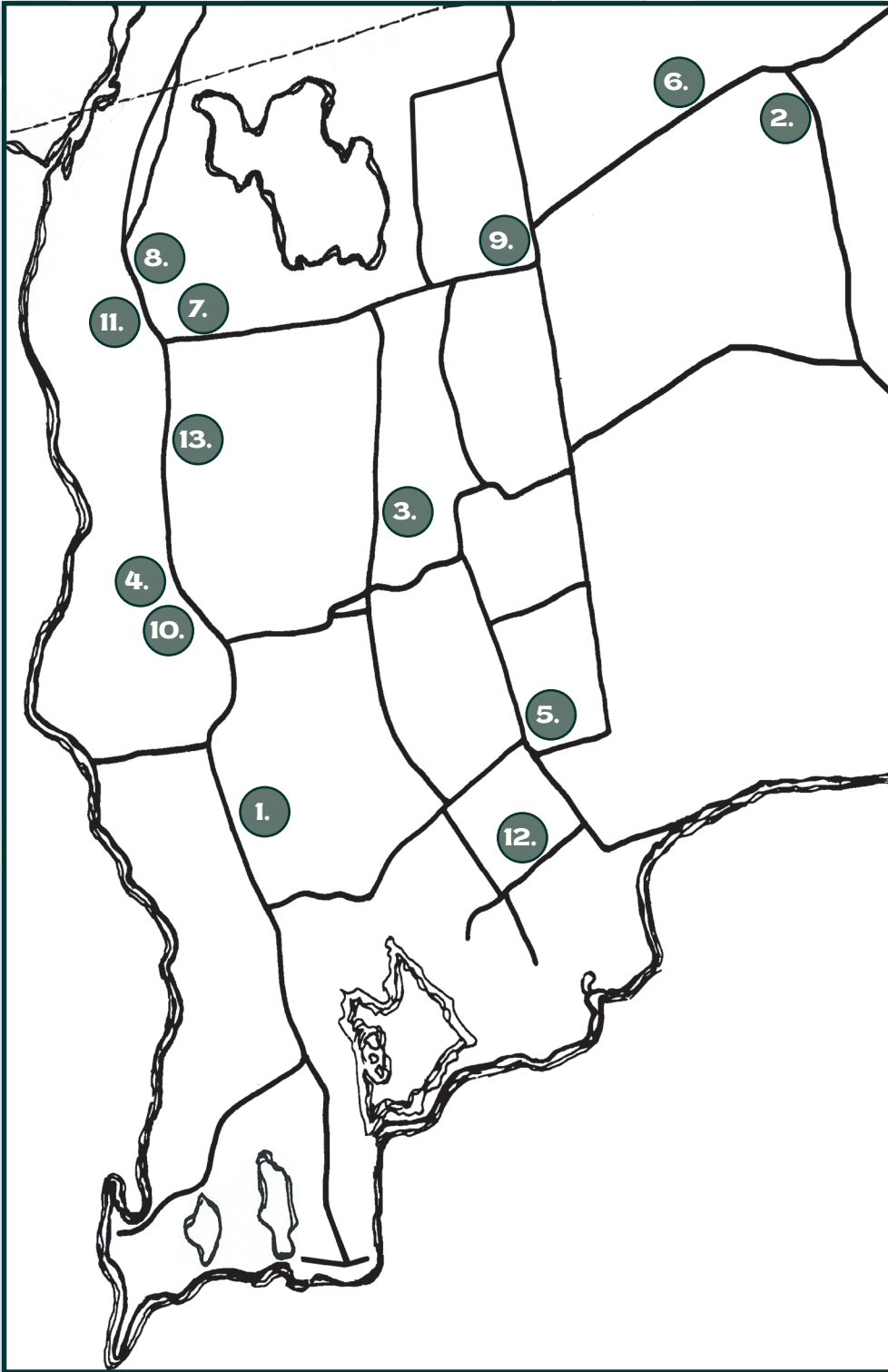

548 West Main Road 10 am - 5 pm

Franlart Nurseries, previously Franlart Dairy Farm, has been in the Goulart family for over 100 years. Today Chris and his team raise trees, bushes, shrubs and other landscaping plantings. Visitors will be able to stroll through the farm and see what they grow. Proprietor Chris Goulart will be on hand to talk about the operation and answer your questions.

GREENWOOD PASTURES 11 am - 5 pm

Visit the giant pumpkin patch at one of Little Compton's newest farms. Meet Cindy the cow and feed her a treat. Learn how you can buy Little Compton raised products directly from the farm or have them delivered to your home.

HOPE ALPACA FARM 11 am - 3 pm

Meet the alpaca herd, miniature donkey, ducks and chickens. Start holiday shopping early with a wide variety of alpaca socks, hats/headbands, gloves/mittens, scarves, plush, farm t-shirts and free trade gifts offered for sale. Alpaca cookies, coloring packets and alpaca fact cards are available on a "first come, first served" basis.

OLD STONE ORCHARD 10 am - 5 pm

33 Colebrook Road, Adamsville
Pick your own apples and pumpkins. Greet the chickens and the other farm animals of Old Stone Orchards.

PECKHAM'S GREENHOUSE 10 am - 5 pm

200 West Main Road
Stop by to stroll multiple greenhouses and shop a wide assortment of indoor and outdoor plants.

SAKONNET VINEYARD 12 pm - 4 pm

162 West Main Road
Guests can walk the vineyard grounds, purchase tasting flights, bottles of wine, and grab and go food for their enjoyment.

SMALL WORLD FARM 10 am - 4 pm

225 Long Highway
Pick your own apples grown with organic methods at Little Compton's newest farm or purchase them pre-picked at the stand. Paint your own pumpkin (\$5). Each visitor will receive a free apple.

TREATY ROCK FARM 11 am - 5 pm

60 Treaty Rock Road (off West Main Road)
Treaty Rock Farm raises grass-fed cattle that are rotationally grazed on oceanside pastures. Come take a driving tour of the historic Treaty Rock Farm. See the herd and the hay bales that will be their winter food. Follow the signs that will guide your driving tour.

WHITE ROCK FARM 12 pm - 4 pm

193 West Main Road
Enjoy a narrated hayride (scheduled every 30 minutes weather permitting) through the farm to the Sakonnet River. Browse the retail store for a selection of farm fresh beef. See the tractors and equipment used to work the farm.

WISHING STONE FARM 10 am - 5 pm

Purchase fresh produce at the market and delicious prepared foods from the farm's kitchen. Visit the special booth welcoming Farm Tour visitors.
